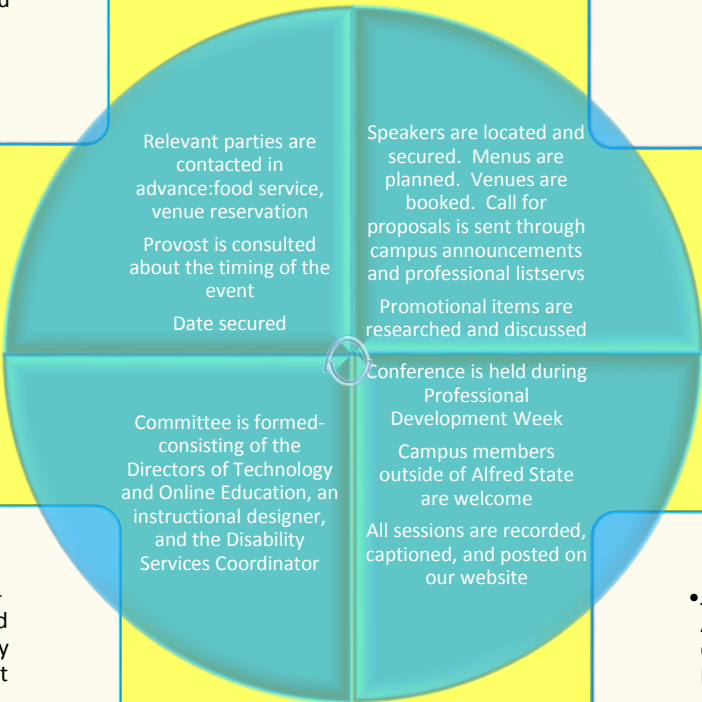


Alfred State Accessibility Conference funded by IITG
